

The North Penn School District School Nutrition Services Department uses a computerized cash register system (point-of-sale system) in school cafeterias.

This system gives parents/guardians the advantage of depositing money into a student account. The money can be used for breakfast and/or lunch purchases as well as other food items sold ala carte in the cafeteria. This eliminates the task of remembering to send money every day and takes the worry out of carrying cash.

There are several ways to deposit funds into your student's account.

1. Send cash in an envelope clearly marked with your student's name, grade, and Student ID number.
2. Send a check or money order, made payable to School Nutrition Services (SNS) in an envelope clearly marked with your student's name, grade, and Student ID number.
3. Create an online account with mypaymentsplus.com and electronically deposit funds into a student's account.

Upon school registration, students are issued an identification number (Student ID), which is also printed at the top of trimester reports of student progress. This number links the student to his/her school lunch account.

Students will type their Student ID into a key pad similar to the one below when purchasing a meal at school. In an effort to prepare students for this new routine, please take time to practice typing the number into this key pad.
